

NOT APPROVED**Annual Town Meeting****March 13, 2012**

The Annual Town Meeting, held in the Town of Camden in the County of Carver and State of Minnesota, at the Camden Town Hall on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of March 2012, was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Roger Sauerbrey, Clerk.

A motion was made by Gerald Goede, seconded by Virgil Stender to elect Donna Baklund as Moderator. Motion carried. The Moderator, at the opening of the meeting, stated the business to be transacted and the order of the same as listed in the agenda and to transact other business as is by law required or permitted.

The Moderator read the meeting notice that was posted at the Town Hall in New Germany.

The clerk read the minutes of the March 8, 2011 Annual Meeting. A motion was made by Stan Werner, seconded by Marvin Meuleners to approve the Minutes as read. Motion carried.

Discussions were held on the proposed 2013 fire contracts. Representing the Plato Fire Dept. was Ryan Neubarth. The proposed contract with Plato for 2013 is \$2,346.00. This includes an estimated truck payment for 2012 and 2013. Representing the NYA Fire Dept. was Steve Noll. The contract with NYA for 2013 is \$15,120.00. An audit was done by the Board of how many units are in the NYA fire district and the count is now 112. The proposed contract with New Germany for 2013 is \$31,006.66. This includes a new Hurst tool for wrecked cars which will cost \$2,000.00 per year for 5 years. The estimated contract with the Mayer Fire Dept. for 2013 is \$11,000.00.

The Clerk presented the 2011 Annual Financial Report for review and any questions were addressed. A motion was made by Marvin Meuleners, seconded by Mike Meuleners to accept the report as printed. Motion carried.

Guests: County Commissioner Jim Ische: The County has a AAA bond rating, County Budget was reduced by 2.9%, burning permits may be issued on line and there will be some redistricting done for commissioner districts. State Representative Ernie Leidiger: gave an update on the state budget talks, the Market Value Credit may be gone, the surplus, school payments and redistricting.

The proposed sums of money to be raised by tax upon the taxable property in said town for the following purposes:

General Fund: \$52,500.00 – A motion was made by Virgil Stender, seconded by Marvin Meuleners to approve the General Fund levy for \$52,500.00. Motion carried.

Road & Bridge Fund: \$200,000.00 - A motion was made by Mike Meuleners, seconded by Marvin Meuleners to approve the Road & Bridge Fund levy for \$150,000.00. Motion carried.

Fire Fund: \$59,000.00 – A motion was made by Marvin Meuleners, seconded by Virgil Stender to approve the Fire Fund levy for \$59,000.00. Motion carried.

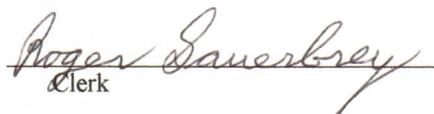
