

## Camden Township Regular Meeting

March 8, 2018

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall March 8, 2018 at 7:30pm. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, Supervisors Gerald Goede, Bill Devine, David Zellmann and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gerald Goede.

A motion made by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve the regular minutes from the February 15, 2018 meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$5,792.30. See attached list. Zellmann and Devine voted yes. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve the Treasurer's report. Motion carried. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Motion carried.

**Clerk's Report:** Shared the City of New Germany's monthly newsletter; Carver County building permits and split parcels issued; county fire service market values; Spring short course Hutchinson 3/28; review and make changes to sample permit form to dig across roadway.

**Supervisor's Report:** Carver County has weed inspection meeting on 3/9 –Caswell will attend. Goede reported he would like to try a Class 5 gravel mixed with asphalt shingles to see how it works. Devine reported on his meeting with lawyer regarding road right of way encroachment issues. The township's original road maps are obsolete. Refer to Minn. Statute 160.20 for further information. Where snow is thrown, is ROW. The county engineer could be contacted for further help in ROW encroachment.

### Discussion Included:

1. Fire chief Dan Ruschmeier from New Germany gave a report on 2017 financials and proposed 2019 fire contract. He also would like the board to remind residents to clear driveways of snow and trim trees, in case any emergency vehicles are called.
2. Representing St. John's Youth group was Terry Zellmann to do annual spring ditch cleaning. Bill Devine represented the Youth group and Adult Mission group from Zion Lutheran Mayer.
3. Jeff Caswell presented a request for a CUP for a 60x72 personal storage shed. Motion by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve. Motion carried.

### Road & Equipment Report:

New maintenance worker Ben Silseth is working out well so far. Snowplowed, hauled rock to 86<sup>th</sup> to prevent flooding. Graded a few roads. Buffalo Creek bridge starting in June with scheduled completion August.
