

Camden Township Regular Meeting

June 14, 2018

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall June 14, 2018 at 7:30pm. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, Supervisors Gerald Goede, Bill Devine, David Zellmann and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gerald Goede.

A motion made by Devine, seconded by Goede to approve the regular minutes from the May 10, 2018 meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$71,518.92, and check #12222 from May 10th. See attached list. Devine voted yes. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the amended Treasurer's report. Motion carried. A motion was made by Devine, seconded by Goede stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Clerk Report: Shared the City of New Germany's monthly newsletter; Carver County building permits and parcel split; Mayer fire calls for April; Met Council annual population estimate of 953 people and 352 households as of April 1, 2017 used to allocate local government and street aid; County service agreements will be increased by 3.43% in 2019; summer short course June 18-21 & June 25-28.

Supervisor Report:

Goede reports work on bridge starting soon. Goede attended Soil & Water meeting – lost 15 ft of banking from river work last year. Will need to advertise for PT maintenance worker. Discussed problems with fabric coming exposed on last year's rebuilt section of Tacoma – will contact Melsha to redo for no cost. Discussed gravel budget & granite. Letter to W. Stender for manure on ROW will be sent.

1. Motion by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve driveway permit request for David Groschen. Motion carried.
2. Motion by Devine, seconded by Goede to approve driveway permit request for Brian Sanders. Motion carried.
3. Set annual Road Inspection for 6/20/18 at 6:30pm.
4. Discussed garbage and recycling – if township takes over, taxes will increase. Was discussed at annual meeting a few years ago, and got voted down.

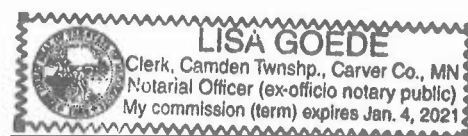
Road & Equipment Report:
