

Camden Township Regular Meeting

July 12, 2018

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall July 12, 2018 at 7:30pm. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, Supervisors Gerald Goede, Bill Devine, David Zellmann and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gerald Goede.

A motion made by Devine, seconded by Goede to approve the regular minutes from the June 14, 2018 regular and June 20 special meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$19,262.46. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the amended Treasurer's report. Motion carried. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Supervisor Report:

Goede reported Melsha will pay for mesh replacement; will dig out soft spots and clean out ditch on Tacoma. Buffalo Creek bridge progressing. Crow River on 84th under water & still a mess. Cost for granite is 24.95; gravel is 15.00 ton. No applications were received for PT maintenance worker. Goede attended summer short course-road weight restrictions discussed.
