

Camden Township Regular Meeting

October 11, 2018

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall October 11, 2018 at 7:30pm. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, Supervisors Gerald Goede, Bill Devine, David Zellmann and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. Also present: Sheriff candidate Jessica Heger, Virgil Stender, Jeff Dettmann, District #110 Superintendent Pat Devine and communications director Paul David. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gerald Goede.

A motion made by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve the regular minutes, with correction to the September 13, 2018 regular meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$20,980.97. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, *being paid for maintenance work*. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the Treasurer's report. Motion carried. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Clerk Report: Shared the City of New Germany's monthly newsletter; Carver County building permits; upcoming CCL meeting 10/23/18; upcoming election info; notice of public hearing meeting 10/16/18 to amend county code and floodplain zoning map ordinance.

Supervisor Report:

Goede reported culvert installed on Vega, ditch cleaned on Tacoma. Heuer's may take dirt. 84th and Crow river-washing out again. May have someone lined up to help with backhoe work. Devine asked about donating to the Veteran Memorial – will include on next year annual meeting agenda.

1. Jeff Dettmann requested driveway permit for new home construction. Motion by Goede, seconded by Devine to approve driveway permit. Motion carried. Form completed and permit paid.
2. Motion by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve Mayer and Plato fire contracts for 2019. Motion carried.
3. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the following general election judges: Arlene Roepke, Kayla Coil-head judge, Betty Gieselmann, Beth Vanderwater, Roger Sauerbrey-head judge, Twyla Menth, Judy Solie, Lisa Goede, Barbara Woida. City of New Germany and Township will be combining this election, meaning one sign in table.
4. Motion by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve Rick Braun as a part-time maintenance worker, pending required background check and screenings. Motion carried.

Road & Equipment Report:

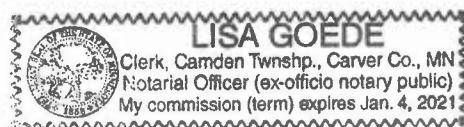
