

Camden Township Regular Meeting

November 8, 2018

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall November 8, 2018 at 7:30pm. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, Supervisors Gerald Goede, Bill Devine, David Zellmann and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. Also present: Frost. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Gerald Goede.

A motion made by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve the minutes of the October 11, 2018 regular meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$18,107.40. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the Treasurer's report. Motion carried. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Clerk Report: Shared the City of New Germany's monthly newsletter; Carver County building permits; public hearing for CUP request 11/20/18; election results; Mayer fire calls for September and October

Supervisor Report:

Klingelhutz asked Goede if township would consider more building eligibilities per 40 acres – it was decided an overwhelming no. 84th and Crow river-washing after redoing. May have someone lined up to help with backhoe work. Devine asked about donating to the Veteran Memorial – will include on next year annual meeting agenda.

1. Terry Frost requested CUP permit for new shed construction. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve CUP request. Motion carried. Form completed and signed.
2. Motion by Devine, seconded by Goede to report No Special Assessments to certify for 2019 Carver County property tax statements. Motion carried.

Road & Equipment Report:



Possible budget item request – a Harley rake to pull with tractor, cost approximately \$8,000. Culverts will get picked up on Vega. 110th St. is still in very bad shape because of CR 33 detour.
