

Camden Township Regular Meeting

January 10, 2019

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall January 10, 2019 at 8:30pm, after Organizational meeting. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, Supervisors Gerald Goede, Bill Devine, David Zellmann and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. Also present: Mike Wanous from Carver County Soil & Water Conservation, residents Patricia Filkens, Glen McPadden and Brian Klingelhutz. The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Gerald Goede.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the minutes of the December 13, 2018 regular meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$11,228.14. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve the Treasurer's report. Motion carried. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Motion carried.

1. Mike Wanous from Carver County Soil & Water presented on the 84th & Crow River project. If fails again, will go to a rip rap plan that the township originally preferred, instead of the current plan of root balls to control erosion and washing away that the DNR and Army Corps engineered. Total project cost was \$204,000.
2. Brian Klingelhutz, Patricia Filkens and Glen McPadden spoke regarding 9770 Stewart Ave. Wants to dedicate 33 ft wide by 475 in length to township of frontage in order to split property as a no maintenance road dedicated to township to grant property split. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Devine. Motion carried.


Road & Equipment Report:
