

Camden Township Regular Meeting

March 14, 2019

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall March 14, 2019 at 7:30pm. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, Supervisors Gerald Goede, Bill Devine, David Zellmann and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the minutes of the February 14, 2019 Regular meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$12,201.04. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Devine, seconded by Zellman to approve the Treasurer's report. Motion carried. A motion was made by Devine, seconded by Zellmann stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Clerk Report: Shared the City of New Germany's monthly newsletter; Carver County building permits; Township Legal Seminar-6/13/19 in Wright county; county flood alerts; Carver county public hearing on 2040 Comp plan-3/19/19.

Supervisor Report:

Goede reported NYA fire department plans a new pumper truck in 2023. Zellmann reported Plato fire department plans a new pumper truck in 2020. Estimated cost for township is \$1290 a year for 7 years. Plato fish fry 2/15, banquet 3/16. Goede also reported will be asking for options for grader warranty. Road postings in effect starting 3/15/19.

2. Mandy Parpart from St. John's Youth group was present to receive instructions on spring ditch cleaning. Supervisor Devine is taking care of the two Zion group's instructions.

4. Discussed what could be done at Feltmann's corner – tabled until next month.


Road & Equipment Report:
