

Camden Township Regular Meeting

April 15, 2019

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall April 15, 2019, at 7:30 pm. Members present were Clerk Lisa Goede, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, Bill Devine and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the regular minutes from the March 14, 2019 meeting, Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$11,929.34. See attached list. Zellmann and Devine voted yes. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balance with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Was informed that sheriff's office can't/won't enforce road restrictions since we don't have a separate contract with them. Discussed washout options at Steve Feltmann's corner.

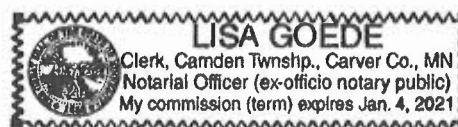
Discussion Included:
