

Camden Township Regular Meeting

June 13, 2019

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall June 13, 2019, at 7:30 pm. Members present were Clerk Lisa Goede, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, Bill Devine and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the regular minutes from the May 9, 2019 meeting, Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$49,433.62. See attached list. Zellmann and Devine voted yes. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balance with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Clerk's Report: Shared City of New Germany's monthly newsletter; Carver County building permits; Carver County 2020 service agreement increase of 3.62%; summer short course date; Jaguar fiber install along 74th St.; Mayer fire calls.

Supervisors Report: Supervisors Devine & Zellmann checked frost boil per resident Dan Stender's request. It was determined resident's responsibility since it's in the owner's driveway. Supervisor Devine gave grass clipping letter to resident at 7775 Tacoma-and possible multiple dwellings discussed. Supervisor Goede stated sheriff was called regarding 2 semi's blocking and digging up road.


Discussion Included:

3. Purchasing a new safe was discussed to spend under \$1,000.
4. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve revised New Germany's fire contract for 2020 in the amount of \$36,928.04.
5. Set annual road inspection meeting for 6/19/19 at 6:30pm.

Road & Equipment Report: 10 miles dust control complete so far with more scheduled next week. Road postings will be removed.
