

Camden Township Regular Meeting

September 12, 2019

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall, September 12, 2019, at 7:30 pm. Members present were Clerk Lisa Goede, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, Bill Devine and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. Also in attendance were City of New Germany Mayor Steve Van Lith, New Germany Fire Chief Dan Ruschmeier and maintenance position candidate Trevor Stewart. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the regular minutes from the August 14, 2019 meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$97,455.94. See attached list. Zellmann and Devine voted yes. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balance with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Treasurer's Report: CD renewed for 2 years with Cortrust Bank (formerly First Minn) at rate of 1.985%.

Clerk's Report: Shared City of New Germany's monthly newsletter; Carver County building permits & variance request; Mayer fire calls; will register board attending annual conference in November.

Supervisors Report: Devine will take letter of request to recoup cost of maintaining 110th St during detour of CR 33 & CR 34 roundabout to county. Will be applying additional dust control for Latzke & Swiggum yet this fall on 110th St.


Discussion Included:

Upcoming fire truck planned purchase moved out to possibly 2021. Also possible addition to New Germany fire station planned was presented.
2. PT maintenance candidate Trevor Stewart present for interview. Motion by Goede, seconded by Zellmann to approve hiring Stewart at \$25/hour pending favorable background check and drug screening.
3. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve levy payable 2020 as approved at the annual meeting in March of \$318,000. Motion carried.


