

Camden Township Regular Meeting

October 10, 2019

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall, October 10, 2019, at 7:30 pm. Members present were Deputy Clerk Roger Sauerbrey, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, Bill Devine. Also in attendance was Jeff Latzke. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the regular minutes from the September 12, 2019 meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$5,856.23. See attached list. Zellmann and Devine voted yes. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Some maintenance needed on the Sterling: may need to take to a repair shop. Some maintenance needed on the cold storage shed doors: may need to call a handyman.


Discussion Included:
