

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall, February 13, 2020 at 7:30 pm. Members present were Clerk Lisa Goede, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, Bill Devine. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the organizational, regular, budget & audit minutes from the January 9, 2020 meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the payroll and claims for payment of \$15,620.19. See attached list. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books balance with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Clerk's Report: Shared City of New Germany's monthly newsletter; Carver County building permits; 2019 Report of Indebtedness completed; Mayer fire calls; election training update for presidential primary 3/3/2020. Will contact maintenance workers for updated DOT medical cards.

Supervisors Report: Goede talked about thoughts on possibly closing 82nd St because of continued flooding. Goede in process of getting quotes on rebuilding part of 94th & Yale Ave. Goede stated that a bigger culvert installed on 86th by Heuer could help with road wash out. Section of Yancy Ave that continues to flood yearly looks to be sinking. Devine contacted county on getting a list of delinquent taxpayers – there is a fee to access this.

Discussion Included:

1. Rod & Andy Maetzold from Mayer fire department spoke about the possibility of dividing fire property taxes equally over township residents. Will research pros and cons for 2022 planning.
2. Richard Parris presented paperwork for a variance at 8180 County Road 33 for reduced road frontage and access to cross his private drive. Motion by Devine, seconded by Goede to approve. Motion carried.
3. Milan Wischnack spoke on his intentions to sell and split his property. Carver county wanted him to make the township aware. A letter was written by township stating the township would not be responsible for additional cartway maintenance.
4. Annual meeting mailing info was finalized and will go to printer ASAP.
5. Motion by Goede, seconded by Zellmann to approve 2020 NYA Fire contract as presented. Motion carried.
6. Spring ditch cleanup groups – 2 from Zion and 1 group from St. John's will be contacted to attend next month's meeting for routes and requirements.
7. Goede's intentions on maintenance worker position. He stated his wishes as staying on as maintenance worker to take care of vehicle maintenance. Motion by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve Goede's rehire. Motion carried.
8. Motion by Devine, seconded by Zellmann to approve the following election judges: Roger Sauerbrey, LeAnn Goede, Barb Woida, Lisa Goede, Twyla Menth and Kayla Coil. Motion carried.
9. Updated road agreement with Hollywood township – tabled for March meeting.

Road & Equipment Report: Motion by Goede, seconded by Zellmann to approve Jeff to attend grader training workshop. Motion carried.
