

Camden Township Regular Meeting

May 14, 2020

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall, maintenance garage to provide social distancing, May 14, 2020 at 7:30 pm. Members present were Clerk Lisa Goede, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, Bill Devine, and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the regular minutes from the March 12, 2020 meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve payroll and claims for payment of \$82,101.42. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the April treasurer's report with 0 claims and receipts since April's meeting was canceled because of Covid-19. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the current month's treasurer's report. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books balance with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Clerk's Report: Shared City of New Germany's monthly newsletter; New Germany Fire Dept. quarterly report; Carver County building permits, Frontier install work scheduled, COVID situation update from Carver County; state auditor 2019 CTAS review.

Supervisors Report: Goede attended Road Right of Way webinar. Ditch cleanup groups are done. The NYA group needs to return some vests yet, payment will be withheld until returned. NYA Fire dept. will be purchasing a ladder truck in 2020 for a savings of \$200,000 from previous quote. Muskrats will need to be trapped.


Discussion Included:

1. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve a driveway permit request and payment from Yaeck. Motion carried.
2. An Interim Use Permit request was requested for Valley Paving to mine gravel from Donald Heuer and Francine Oswald properties on 86th St. Representation for this request was Nick Bono from Carlson McCain, John Wokasch and Joe White from Valley Paving. The request is to operate from these 2 locations for 5-10 years. Land will be returned to ag after mining. The Township will require dust control applied, to repair road traveled to same or better condition. A motion to approve IUP request was made by Goede, seconded by Zellmann. Motion carried.
3. Reviewed Road Agreement with Hollywood Township for 62nd St. Changes noted and will be sent to Hollywood Township for their review.
4. Annual Workplace Accident and Injury Reduction Review was completed.

Road & Equipment Report: Dust control started, more schedule next week, but need rain. Road restrictions will be taken down at maintenance dept. discretion. County is working on 84th St – hauling field and crushed rock.
