

**Camden Township Regular Meeting**

**June 11, 2020**

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall, June 11, 2020 at 7:30 pm. Members present were Clerk Lisa Goede, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, Bill Devine, and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the regular minutes from the May 14, 2020 meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve payroll, and claims for payment of \$80,386.28, noting check number 12839 is voided. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the treasurer’s report. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine stating that the Clerk and Treasurer’s books balance with the bank statement. Motion carried.

**Clerk’s Report:** Shared Carver County building permits, 2021 Service Agreement for assessment work-no change from 2020; annual population estimate from Met Council – 955 people and 344 households as of 4/1/2019.

**Supervisors Report:** Goede noted NYA fire department paperwork will be coming for their purchase of a ladder truck. Camden’s portion will be approximately \$45,000. Jaguar cut some culverts – they were told the township needs to inspect when work is being done. Grader will have a live link tracker mounted for no cost. The NYA group still needs to return some vests yet, payment will be withheld until returned. A culvert that may need to be cleaned out by Dan Vinkemeier will be looked at during road inspection.


**Discussion Included:**


1. Resident Cathy Deering expressed her concern on lack of reliable rural internet and if there is anything the township or residents can do to access a Connect America Fund.
2. Resident Mike Deering appealed to the township for having dust control applied on Union Ave. to consider for safety of pedestrians because of speed and dust. A traffic counter will be set up to track, and then revisit this issue.
3. Annual Road Inspection scheduled for 6/24/2020 at 6:30pm.

**Road & Equipment Report:** Dust control almost complete, 4.5 miles remain. Road restrictions will be taken down at maintenance dept. discretion. Stan Werner asked about an issue with pocket gophers. Muskrats will be trapped.
