

**Camden Township Regular Meeting**

**December 10, 2020**

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall, December 10, 2020 at 7:30 pm. Members present were Clerk Lisa Goede, Treasurer Denise Zellmann, Supervisors Gerry Goede, David Zellmann, Bill Devine, and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Bill Devine.

A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the regular minutes from the November 10, 2020 meeting. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve payroll, and claims for payment of \$68,014.74. See attached list. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion made by Zellmann, seconded by Devine to approve the Treasurer’s report, stating that the Clerk and Treasurer’s .01 difference due to rounding on PERA payment. Motion carried.

**Clerk’s Report:** Voided check #12979 due to printing error; Shared Carver County building permits; 2020 solid waste grant reimbursement requested; 2021 solid waste grant participation will be requested; annual work comp audit to be completed by 1/31/21.

**Supervisors Report:** Goede stated new address signs installed; trees crossing property line behind shed – need to talk to property owner. Goede has been talking to property owners that were leaving snow piles on road-all understand and will comply and understand they would be charged if township must remove snow piles. Discussed possible survey of Stewart Ave, noting that our old, certified surveys may not be sufficient any longer.


**Discussion Included:**

3. Possible virtual annual meeting in March, at the least social distance meeting most likely. Will look to MAT for guidance.
4. Road right of way issues – may contact our lawyer after COVID to attend meeting to discuss.

**Road & Equipment Report:** New disc mower picked up from Lano. Discussed option of snow wheels, instead of current shoes for possible purchase for \$5,000/truck – possible budget item for next budget meeting.
