

## Annual Town Meeting

March 12, 2013

The Annual Town Meeting, held in the Town of Camden in the County of Carver and State of Minnesota, at the Camden Town Hall on the 12<sup>th</sup> day of March 2013, was called to order at 7:00 P.M. by Donna Baklund, Clerk.

A motion was made by Gerald Goede, seconded by Virgil Stender to appoint Roger Sauerbrey as Moderator. Motion carried. The Moderator, at the opening of the meeting, stated the business to be transacted and the order of the same as listed in the agenda and to transact other business as is by law required or permitted.

The Moderator read the meeting notice that was posted at the Town Hall in New Germany.

The clerk read the minutes of the March 13, 2012 Annual Meeting. A motion was made by David Zellmann, seconded by Virgil Stender to approve the Minutes as read. Motion carried.

Discussions were held on the proposed 2014 fire contracts. Representing the Plato Fire Dept. was Ryan Neubarth. The proposed contract with Plato for 2014 is \$2,100.14. This includes an estimated truck payment for 2014.

The contract with NYA for 2014 is \$15,680.00. An audit was done by the Board of how many units are in the NYA fire district and the count is now 112.

The proposed contract with New Germany for 2014 is \$30,390.61. This includes a new Hurst tool for wrecked cars which will cost \$2,000.00 per year for 5 years.

The estimated contract with the Mayer Fire Dept. for 2014 is \$10,872.00.

The Clerk presented the 2012 Annual Financial Report for review and any questions were addressed. A motion was made by Dan Feltmann, seconded by Bryan Baklund to accept the report as printed. Motion carried.

Guests: Jason Kamerud and Jake Hodge discussed the new Police Contract. They will be making regular patrol routes in the township keeping order to the peace. Also the township will receive a percentage of revenue from traffic tickets given in the township limits.

The proposed sums of money to be raised by tax upon the taxable property in said town for the following purposes:

General Fund: \$50,000.00 – A motion was made by Mike Meuleners, seconded by Stan Werner to approve the General Fund levy for \$50,000.00. Motion carried.

Road & Bridge Fund: \$150,000.00 - A motion was made by Mike Meuleners, seconded by David Zellmann to approve the Road & Bridge Fund levy for \$100,000.00. Motion carried.


Fire Fund: \$59,000.00 – A motion was made by Mike Meuleners, seconded by Dan Feltmann to approve the Fire Fund levy for \$59,000.00. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mike Meuleners, seconded by David Zellmann to recommend the following papers for the publishing of legal notices: The Waconia Patriot, NYA Times and the Herald Journal. Motion carried.

A motion was made by Mike Meuleners, seconded by Orville Dietel to hold the 2014 annual meeting on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Tuesday in March at 7:00 P.M. at the township shed. Motion carried.

Open discussion: Dust coating new gravel that was received last year and also new gravel that will be put down this year.

There being no further discussion or business, a motion was made by Dan Feltmann, seconded by Mike Meuleners to adjourn. Motion carried at 8:08 P.M.
