

Camden Township Regular Meeting

December 10, 2015

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall December 10th, 2015 at 7:30 PM. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, and Supervisors Gerald Goede, David Zellmann, Virgil Stender and maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Virgil Stender and was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the minutes from the November 12th, 2015 regular meeting. Approval was unanimous. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Stender to approve the payroll and claims for payment in the amount of \$21,752.25. See attached list. Zellmann and Stender voted yes. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the Treasurer's report. Approval was unanimous. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Approval was unanimous.

Clerk's Report: Shared the monthly newsletter from New Germany. Shared the building permits from Carver County for Camden TWP. Shared Carver County Sheriff's report for Camden TWP. Shared Couri & Ruppe, PLLP's rate notice for 2016. Shared Mayer FD calls.

Supervisor's Report: Supervisor Stender reported on the inquiry of having one garbage hauler for the township. This will be an agenda item for the Annual Meeting. A No Trespassing sign will be put up on dead end road at 70th St. Discussed what to do with brick & river rock around culvert in road right-of-way.

Discussion included:

1. Resolution 2015-7 requiring drug testing and background checks for all newly hired employees. Motion by Stender, seconded by Zellmann. Motion carried.
2. Will send Joint Powers Agreement from Carver County for bridge no. 10508 reconstruction to Couri & Ruppe for their review and signature as required by county.

Road Report:

1. Will need to replace culvert on 94th St in 2016. Estimate cost of \$10,000. New PT snow plow employee hired. Roads extremely wet and sloppy due to warm and rainy weather.
