

## Camden Township Regular Meeting

March 10, 2016

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall March 10, 2016 at 7:30 PM. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, Supervisors Gerald Goede, Virgil Stender, David Zellmann, and maintenance Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Virgil Stender.

A motion was made by Zellmann and seconded by Goede to approve the minutes from the February 11th regular meeting. Motion carried. A motion was made by Stender, seconded by Zellmann to approve the payroll and claims for payment for \$6,629.37. See attached list. Zellmann and Stender voted yes. - c. Interim Use Permit request from Curt Ladd to renew an expiring 10 year IUP for a mobile home for parent/grandparent. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve request. Motion carried.
- d. Annual meeting follow up – will contact county for their help to obtain number of fire units covered for each fire department.
