

Camden Township Regular Meeting

April 14, 2016

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall April 14, 2016 at 7:30 PM. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, and Supervisors Gerald Goede, Virgil Stender, David Zellmann. Also present were maintenance Jeff Caswell and resident Bill Devine. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Virgil Stender and was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

A motion was made by Zellmann and seconded by Stender to approve the minutes from the March 10th regular meeting and April 4th special meeting. Motion carried. A motion was made by Stender, seconded by Zellmann to approve the payroll and claims for payment for \$5,990.93. See attached list. Zellmann and Stender voted yes. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. Motion carried. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the Treasurer's report. Motion carried. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Stender stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Motion carried.

Clerk's Report: Shared the City of New Germany's monthly newsletter. Shared the Special Assessments for Camden from Carver County; March Sheriff's report; Notice of Pay Equity Compliance certificate from state; Legal Short course training date of April 21st in Burnsville; Sheriff's office recognition evening invite April 26th; April 11-15 is "Severe Weather Awareness Week". Will be attending "New Clerk Meet & Greet" at county on April 18th regarding elections. Shared the following fire units obtained from county – Mayer-70, NG-148, NYA-114, and Plato-14. Received certified Joint Powers Agreement from county for Bridge 10508 reconstruction.

Supervisor's Report: Township cleanup day is 5/21/16. Discussed Curt & Cindy Ladd IUP/CUP renewal request approved by board in March. After further discussion, board reversed its decision. A letter will be sent to notify the Ladd's ASAP before county meeting April 19th. Stender and Goede will attend this meeting.

Discussion included:

1. Don Dolezal presented a Land Use Application to build house at his property 84th St.
2. Tim and Alicia Menzel presented plans for a personal storage shed on their property at 9780 Yale Ave, New Germany where a CUP is required. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Stender to approve. Motion carried.
3. David & Erica Waldvogel presented variance request plans for a type 3 septic system required at their new home construction site at 7290 Union Ave, Mayer. Their original perk test was not applicable. They have been working with the county on this. Variance was approved.
4. Spring short course that was attended by Goede and Stender - discussion was tabled until May.
5. The Board will complete the Annual Review of the AWAIR Program (Workplace Accident and Injury Reduction Program) in May.
6. Election judge process discussed – motion by Goede, seconded by Stender to pay \$15 per hour for extra help for election. Clerk to attend meeting regarding elections at county for new clerks on April 18th.


Road & Equipment Report:

4-wheeler rolled over at 70th St Bridge - no injuries. Fencing and posts to be installed to prevent any further mishaps. County paying for dust control on Yale because of increased traffic was discussed where road is closed on County Rd 30. One group has not done road ditch clean up yet. Wrestling group will be contacted to get done ASAP. Should be completed by 4/24 or township has another group willing to do it.

Grader purchase – it was decided to go with the CAT. Township will sell old grader with a sealed bid process after new grader has arrived. Township will finance \$100,000 for up to 84 months.
