

Camden Township Regular Meeting

September 8, 2016

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall September 8, 2016 at 7:30 PM. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, and Supervisors Gerald Goede, David Zellmann and Virgil Stender. Also present was maintenance worker Jeff Caswell. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Virgil Stender and was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

A motion was made by Stender, seconded by Goede to approve the minutes from the August 11th regular meeting. Approval was unanimous. A motion was made by Stender, seconded by Goede to approve correction to the minutes from the July 14th regular meeting. A motion was made by Stender, seconded by Zellmann to approve the payroll and claims for payment for \$6,350.15. See attached list. Zellmann and Stender voted yes. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, *being paid for maintenance work*. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the Treasurer's report. Approval was unanimous. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Approval was unanimous.

Clerk's Report: Shared the City of New Germany monthly newsletter. Shared the building permits from Carver County for Camden TWP. Shared the Mayer Fire report. Shared town cleanup date of 9/10/16. Grader finance documents were completed.

Supervisor's Report: Goede attended Mayer's fire 2017 contract meeting earlier in the evening. The amount proposed for Camden township is \$15,588.90. Motion by Zellmann, seconded by Stender to approve contract. Motion carried. Discussed options for snow plowing.

New Business: Robert & Rebekah Melchert are requesting a variance for a garage addition with an upstairs bedroom on his property on Sunset Road. The variance is for 618-620 feet instead of the required 1000 from livestock. Variance was granted.


Discussion included:
