

Camden Township Regular Meeting

October 13, 2016

The Town Board of the Town of Camden, Carver County, Minnesota met at the Camden Town Hall October 13, 2016 at 7:30 PM. Members present were Lisa Goede, Clerk, Denise Zellmann, Treasurer, and Supervisors Gerald Goede, David Zellmann and Virgil Stender. Also present was maintenance worker Jeff Caswell and resident Bill Devine. The meeting was called to order by Chairman Virgil Stender and was opened with the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag.

A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Stender to approve the minutes from the September 8th regular meeting. Approval was unanimous. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Stender to approve the payroll and claims for payment for \$19,640.79. See attached list. Zellmann and Stender voted yes. Goede abstained due to a conflict of interest, being paid for maintenance work. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Goede to approve the Treasurer's report. Approval was unanimous. A motion was made by Zellmann, seconded by Stender stating that the Clerk and Treasurer's books are balanced with the bank statement. Approval was unanimous.

Clerk's Report: 2017 Mayer Fire contract was signed. One dust control bill still remains unpaid. Shared the City of New Germany monthly newsletter. Shared the building permits from Carver County for Camden TWP. Shared the Mayer Fire report.

Supervisor's Report: Culverts discussed. County surveyed culvert replacement on 92nd, and all is okay. Zellmann will invite Duane Wolf and Bruce Clark to next meeting to discuss their tile and staves in culvert that's in road right of way. Goede recommends putting new building plans on hold, since cost to fix eroded road on 84th is increasing. Also, the bridge replacement cost is increasing. Discussion regarding claims paid to attend certain meetings – fire department and contract signing for grader.

New Business: Motion by Stender, seconded by Zellmann to approve Plato fire contract. October 26th is test deck testing for the upcoming election at Carver County government center. 2 people for each ballot style are required. Clerk needs a few volunteers.

Road Report: Goede/Caswell

2 washout areas – one on 94th St, and one on Vega Ave. Letters will be sent to property owners' for signature to have township fix. McPadden cart way has a buckthorn problem. County will be contacted to possibly use their equipment. New tires are being installed on blue truck.

Public Comments: A motion was made by Stender, seconded by Zellmann to adjourn at 9:10 P.M. Approval was unanimous.
